She wrote Poems on Various Subjects, Religious and Moral, making her the first African American and first slave to publish a volume of poetry. Phillis Wheatley, First African-American Poet Phillis Wheatley (ca 1753 - December 5, 1784) was born in Senegal / Gambia, Africa. She was America's first African-American poet and one of the first women to be published in colonial America. She was also the first slave in the U.S. to have a book of poetry published. Phillis Wheatley | American Battlefield Trust Many Americans are unaware that the institution of slavery was practiced in all the original thirteen colonies before the start of the American Revolution. One of America's early literary giants, was an enslaved woman from Massachusetts, Phillis Wheatley.

Phillis Wheatley - americanliterature.com Phillis Wheatley (1753-1784) was the first African American female poet to be published. She was born in West Africa, sold into slavery and transported to Boston when she was 7 or 8, purchased by the Wheatley family, who taught her to read and encouraged her talent for writing. Phillis Wheatley - Slave Poet of Colonial America The American Revolution intervened in Phillis Wheatley's career, and the effect was not completely positive. The people of Boston -- and of America and England -- bought books on other topics rather than the volume of Phillis Wheatley poems.
